New York State mandate and Cornell University regulations require:

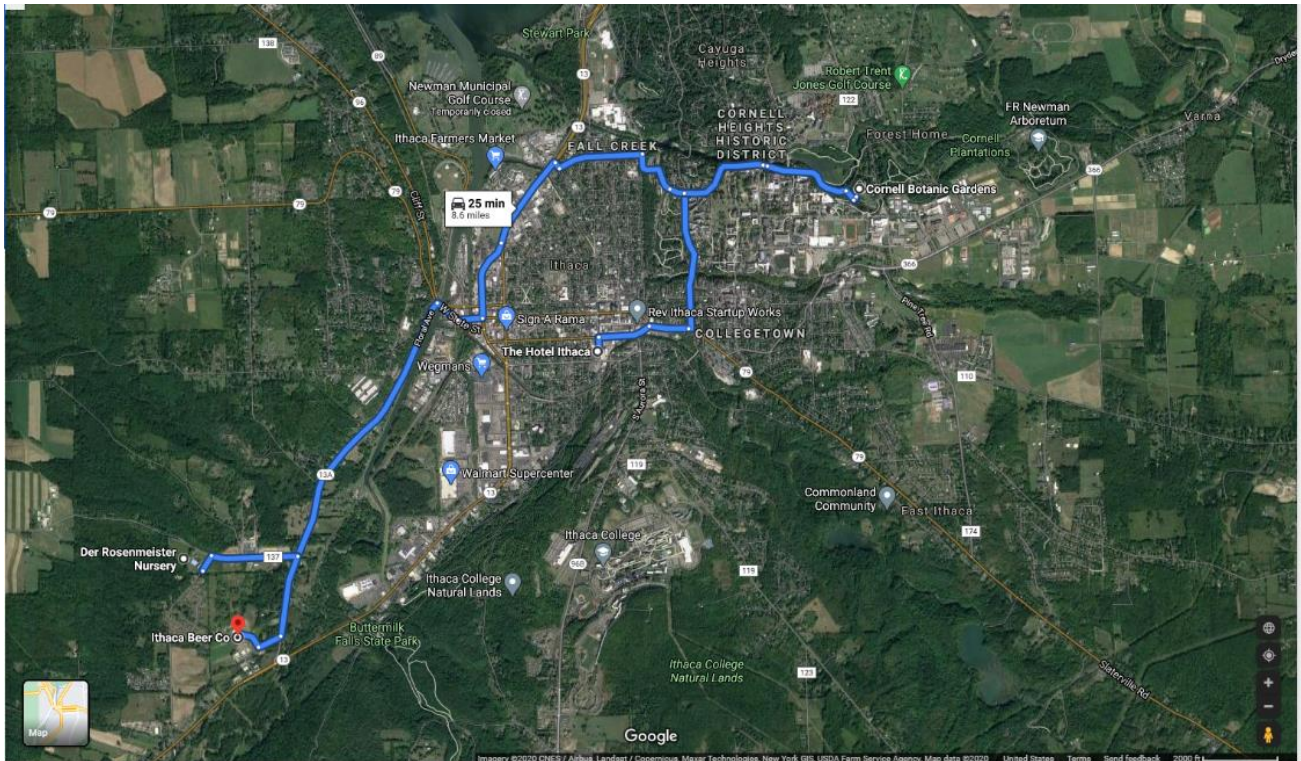
- Maintain at least a 6-foot distance from others

- No restroom facilities, permanent or temporary, are available in any area of Cornell Botanic Gardens
- The Nevin Welcome Center is closed until further notice
